Public transportation from the airport to the city centre

We recommend using the 100E bus which is a shuttle service providing a direct connection between Ferenc Liszt International Airport and Budapest city centre

Please note that passengers require a special ticket for 100E Airport Express, a special fare applies to this bus, and only the Airport shuttle bus single ticket is accepted.

- Cost: 2200 HUF / €5.58
 - Buy and validate the tickets directly on the bus using your bankcard for the Budapest Pay&GO service.
 - Validating your ticket: You will find the Pay&GO machines at all the doors of the 100E Airport Express: on the right side of the driver for the first door and on the right side of the door for the second and third doors.

• The majority of BKK tickets and passes, (including the 100E Airport Express ticket) are now available digitally in the BudapestGO app.

100E Airport Express boarding points in the city centre on the way to the airport:

- Deák Ferenc tér metro station
- Astoria metro station (this stop is served only between 00:12 and 04:32 in the morning)
- Kálvin tér metro station



Please note that there is also bus 200E which is the regular, scheduled public transport service, and can be used with regular single tickets. However, this service has different stops, and will not transfer you directly into the city centre!

Between the airport and the city centre




The typical taxi fare between the city centre and the airport (21 km) is 10 670 HUF, but it can increase depending on traffic.

TAXI

Taxi from the airport to the city centre:

- Getting a taxi at Budapest airport involves using the Hungarian taxi company called FőTaxi. It is the official authorized company at the exit of terminals 2A and 2B of the Liszt Ferenc International Airport of Budapest.
- When you exit the arrival hall, on the outside sidewalks of the two terminals you will find the **kiosk of Főtaxi** where taxis are waiting.
- Taxi fares from the airport to the city centre is usually between 10,000-15,000 HUF (€ 28-38).
- Between the airport and the venue of the Brainhealth conference, a taxi ride takes about 15-20 minutes, and costs about 7,500 HUF (~ € 19).




Public transportation in the city

BKK = Transportation company of Budapest

Fares:

- Single tickets costs 450 HUF (€ 1.14), and you can buy them in a 10 block for 4,000 HUF (€ 10.15). These tickets needs to be validated at every use, but it is good to know, that if you change a metro line during your journey, you do not have to validate another ticket.
- Travel passes are also available, there is a 24 hour option for 2,500 HUF (€ 6.34), a 72 hour travel-card for 5,500 HUF (€ 13.95), or a 15 day Budapest-pass for 5,950 HUF (€ 15.10). Day tickets (24H) and passes do not need to be validated at boarding and are valid for an unlimited number of journeys within the validity period.
- You can pay by a contact and contactless bankcard or even in cash with coins, and banknotes, but be aware that the **ticket machines and most offices will not accept Euro in cash.**

Where and how to buy tickets?



• Most BKK tickets and passes are available digitally, also in the BudapestGO app, but of tickets and passes can be purchased from BKK ticket machines located

• Buying tickets at the airport:

• A wide range of tickets and season tickets can be purchased at the BKK Customer Centres located in terminals 2A and 2B, as well as from BKK ticket machines located near the terminal entrances.

• The menu of BKK ticket machines is available in English and German in addition to Hungarian.






This is a so called TVM (Ticket Vending Machine)

How to validate your tickets?

- Tickets must be validated at the start of the journey: paper tickets must be validated using the device (picture); mobile tickets by scanning the code stickers, which are located outside the metro entrance and at the doors of other vehicles. Time-based tickets (30 and 90-minute tickets), which can only be purchased on mobile phones, must be validated at each boarding.
